

SEA-PAC 2019 Seminar and Workshop Venues

This document attempts to share what we know about venues used by the SEA-PAC Convention. Questions are welcome, and as we learn more, we plan to update the document.

Note: if your preferred computer is an Apple product, it would help if you have the interface between your computer or tablet and VGA or HDMI. I believe the Convention Center may have a few interfaces we can borrow, but that is unconfirmed.

SEASIDE CONVENTION CENTER

In 2019 we plan to use the Seaside Rooms (A, B, and C), Riverside Rooms (A, B, and C), and the Sunrise Room upstairs for workshops, seminars, and meetings. We may also use the Seamist Room downstairs for some meetings. While we have not yet determined room configurations for Seaside ABC, the Riverside Rooms will each host separate seminar sessions.

New this year will be screens outside each room that will show the room schedule. We believe those will be operating before the convention.

Likely seminar room info

Some details are not yet determined. The information below is our best guess.

- Riverside A: Single room with presenter at the east end. Participants enter from the west (rear) of the room.
- Riverside B: Single room with presenter at the west end. Participants enter from the west (front) of the room.
- Riverside C: Single room with presenter at the east end. Participants enter from the west (rear) of the room.
- Seaside A: Single room with presenter at the north end. Participants enter from the east (side) of the room.
- Seaside B: Single room with presenter at the west end (probably). Participants enter from the east (front) of the room. We may combine Seaside B and C, in which case the presenter would be at the south end and participants would enter from the side.
- Seaside C: Single room with presenter at the south end. Participants enter from the east (side) of the room.
- Sunrise: Single room with unknown orientation.
- Seamist: Single room with presenter at the north end. Participants enter from the south (rear) of the room.

Audio/Visual

Riverside A and C will have a large screen on the east side (towards the river) backed up by blackout curtains. The projector is ceiling mounted pointing east. Riverside B will use a portable projector on a

stand pointing west and project on the wall. Connections include both VGA and HDMI. Each room has a separate built-in sound system.

Seaside Rooms will use ceiling-mounted projectors. Seaside A projects north, Seaside C projects south, and Seaside B will probably project east against the wall. We believe the sound can be separated by room, but that is not yet confirmed. Connections include both VGA and HDMI.

The Sunrise Room (south past Seaside C/Riverside C and around the corner) will have a portable projector and use the wall unless that proves unsatisfactory.

If needed, we can provide a microphone for speakers, although generally that has not been necessary in the past except for the ARRL Forum. We do need to know this in advance.

SEASIDE ELKS LODGE

We have not decided yet whether or not we will host a workshop at the Elks Lodge. If so, we will provide a bright projector, and hopefully a larger screen than last year.

SHILOH INN AT THE SHORE

The Shiloh hosts the DX and the YL Luncheons. SEA-PAC will provide excellent projectors for both rooms, and the hotel will provide the sound system.
