

SEA-PAC 2020 Seminar and Workshop Venues

This document attempts to share what we know about venues used by the SEA-PAC Convention. Questions are welcome, and as we learn more, we plan to update the document.

Note: if your preferred computer is an Apple product, it would help if you have the interface between your computer or tablet and VGA or HDMI. I believe the Convention Center may have a few interfaces we can borrow, but that remains unconfirmed.

SEASIDE CONVENTION CENTER

In 2020 we plan to use the Seaside Rooms (A, B, and C), Riverside Rooms (A, B, and C), the Sunrise Room upstairs, and the Seamist Room downstairs for workshops, seminars, and meetings. The Room Configuration document on the Presenter Portal shows the current room configuration plans (not yet posted).

New this year will be screens outside each room that will show the room schedule. We believe those will be operating before the convention. This remains unconfirmed but highly likely.

Likely seminar room info

Some details are not yet determined. The information below is our best guess.

- Riverside A: Single room with presenter at the east (window) end. Participants enter from the west (rear) of the room. Blackout curtains will block direct sunlight.
- Riverside B: Single room with presenter at the east (window) end. Participants enter from the west (front) of the room. Blackout curtains will block direct sunlight.
- Riverside C: Single room with presenter at the east (window) end. Participants enter from the west (rear) of the room. Blackout curtains will block direct sunlight.
- Seaside A: Single room with presenter at the north end. Participants enter from the east (side) of the room.
- Seaside B: Single room with presenter at the east end. Participants enter from the east (front) of the room.
- Seaside C: Single room with presenter at the south end. Participants enter from the east (side) of the room.
- Sunrise: Single room with presenter at the east end. Participants enter from the east (back) of the room.
- Seamist: Single room with presenter at the north end. Participants enter from the south (back) of the room.

Audio/Visual

Riverside A, B, and C will have a large screen on the east side (towards the river) backed up by blackout curtains. The projector is ceiling mounted pointing east. Video connections in all rooms use HDMI

connections. Each room will also have an HDMI to VGA adapter. Please remember to leave the adapter in the room when you pack up your gear.

Seaside A and C Rooms will use ceiling-mounted projectors. Seaside A projects north, Seaside C projects south, and Seaside B will project east against the wall. We believe the sound can be separated by room, but that is not yet confirmed.

The Sunrise Room (south past Seaside C/Riverside C and around the corner) will have a large screen TV at the east end.

If needed, we can provide a microphone for speakers, although generally that has not been necessary in the past except for the ARRL Forum. We do need to know this in advance.

SEASIDE ELKS LODGE

We will not use the Elks Lodge for any events this year.

SHILOH INN AT THE SHORE

The Shiloh hosts the DX and the YL Luncheons. SEA-PAC will provide excellent projectors for both rooms, and the hotel will provide the sound system.
